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Explanation Orofacial Physiotherapy (Jaw Physiotherapy)

Orofacial physiotherapy is a specialization within physiotherapy. The orofacial physiotherapist is a specialist who assists with health problems related to the improper functioning of muscles and joints in the head, neck area, and masticatory system. This physiotherapist is also commonly referred to as a jaw physiotherapist. There is often close collaboration with the general practitioner, ENT specialist, dentist, orthodontist, oral surgeon, dental gnathologist, or another medical specialist.

The orofacial physiotherapist is extensively trained in dental aspects, specific nerve disorders, cancer in the head-neck area, and specific disorders related to the neck. Therefore, the orofacial physiotherapist is the expert who can advise and guide you on pain and functional problems in the head, face, and neck region.
